

Exit on University Avenue South/West. Proceed for several miles on University Avenue. University Avenue becomes Palm Drive after you pass El Camino Real. Take Palm Drive past Arboretum Road, then turn right on Campus Drive and follow the road directly to the Clark Center. Free parking is available after 4:00 p.m. next to the Clark Center.

From 280 North or South:

Exit Sand Hill Road East and follow it for several miles. Take a right on Arboretum Road, then another right on Quarry Road. Turn right on Campus Drive and follow it directly to the Clark Center. Free parking is available after 4:00 p.m. next to the Clark Center.
